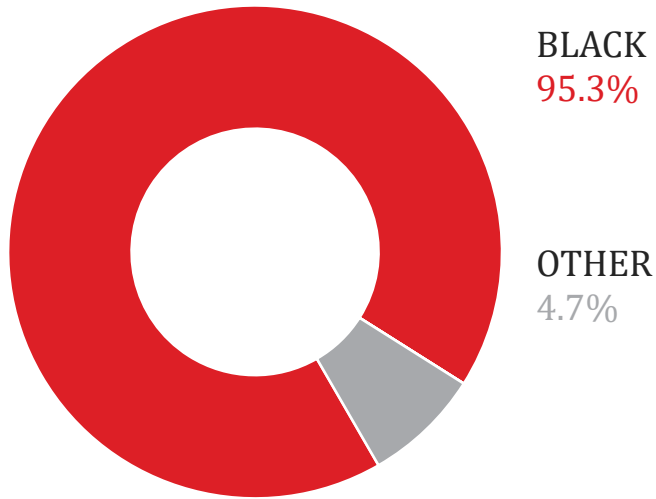

Student Demographics

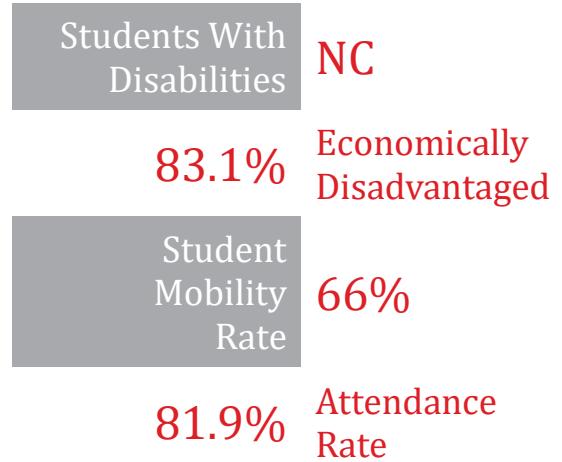

In Reading (iReady), 6-8th grade students demonstrating progress at or above the annual typical growth rate was 146%. In Math (iReady), 195% of 6-8th grade students demonstrated progress at or above the annual typical growth rate.

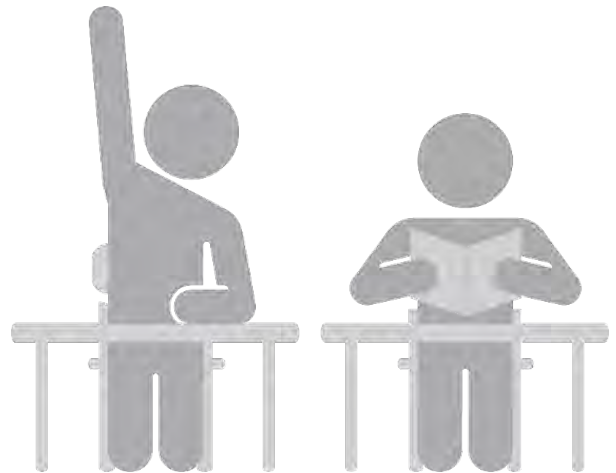
Our Academic Goals

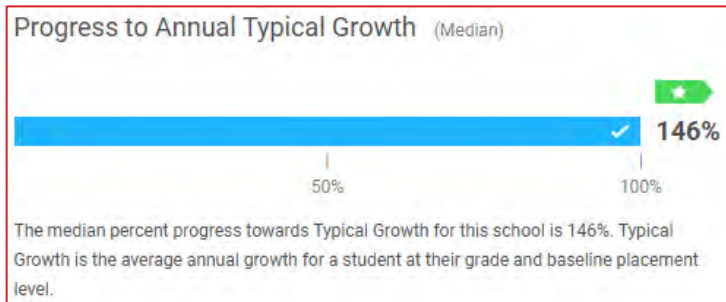

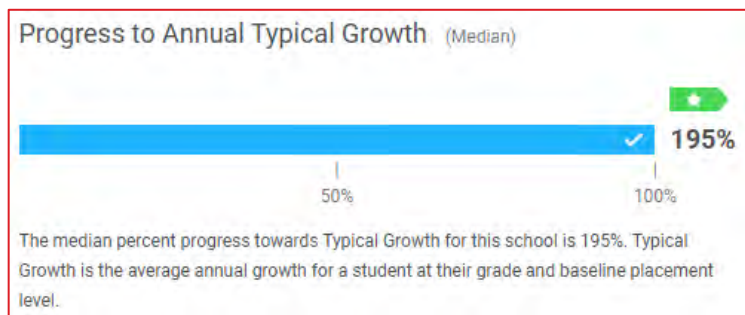
